



**68% of Virtualization Users Plan to Move to Citrix, Oracle or Microsoft  
Majority of virtualization users find they will move from VMware to other leading technologies in near future**

PLANO, TX – TDI and Virtualization Review held a web conference on July 22<sup>nd</sup> attended by over 500 firms using virtualization. The web meeting polled the users with the following question:

***“Are you planning on using products like Citrix XEN, Oracle or Microsoft for virtualization?”***

<b>Yes</b>	<b>68.2%</b>
<b>No</b>	<b>31.8%</b>

“The move to a multi-vendor virtualization environment is what our customers have been predicting,” said Bill Johnson, CEO of TDI ([www.tditx.com](http://www.tditx.com)). Johnson added: “The typical customer will have different applications running on many virtual platforms. That will become a management and security challenge which firms are just beginning to realize. We have done extensive work with our customer base developing the technology to address their needs in the virtual environment.”

Virtualization today is overwhelmingly delivered on VMware platforms. However, this finding from over 500 firms implementing virtualization shows this is going to change in a significant manner. Companies are learning that different platforms and hypervisors have unique traits for certain applications.

Virtualization hypervisor technologies are springing up everywhere these days posing the challenge to learn all the tools and processes used to manage and log the VM's. The findings of this poll also suggest that firms may not want to be locked into one vendor. One of the challenges from this startling finding is how a company will manage multiple virtualization platforms from a single point.
